We have so many reasons to give thanks. Kids are safe and sound in North America. Whitney Louise was born October 10, 7.15lbs to Matt and Keara.





#### **FFI Vocational Training Preparations**

Nancy is very busy writing training materials for our vocational students and future mothers we will meet. At the time of this writing she crafting lectures and handouts regarding breast feeding and lessons regarding nutrition and hygiene.

The last we wrote Nancy was involved in a mobile dental clinic, which was a huge success. A follow-up visit is planned in five months. Our dentist is willing to join the team again to lead another clinic. This clinic was the first-time patients ever received a fluoride treatment for their teeth. The team was able to purchase several tooth brushes, tooth paste, to give to patients.

Please pray for our people on the entire island. There is so much unemployment.



Of course Tim has a small group of nine men who gather as often as possible over the joy of like hobbies—please be careful not to judge.


